2024 Membership Renewal Facts (side 1 of 2)

- Membership renewal invoices were mailed to all members the first week of October. If you're reading this insert—you've received yours.
- Membership Renewal Fees are due by December 31, 2024
- From January 1 to January 31, 2024, the renewal fee may still be paid with an added **\$20.00 late payment fee**.
- Once your payment is received, we will advance the expiration date on your "All-in-One" Access Card until December 31, 2024. You will not receive a paper membership card from National nor will you need to obtain a new "All-in-One" Access Card.
- **On February 1, 2024, if unpaid, your membership in the Chapter will lapse.** To become reinstated will require you to pay the new member initiation fee, the 2024 dues, plus work the 20 hours of volunteer service effort in the first year after rejoining.
- If you have no "All-in One" Access Card, or you have any error in your postal mail address or you have recently changed your email address or phone number, please inform Sandy Stanford at **stanfolr@comcast.net** or place a note in your renewal envelope.

2024 - Other Chapter Facts (side 2 of 2)

- **This notice will be the only Chapter information you will receive from the Chapter this year through the U. S. Postal Service**
- Starting in 2016, the Chapter has chosen electronic media exclusively (except renewal notice) for communicating with its members using:

- Email reminders via MailChimp if you are not receiving the email distribution from the chapter (approx. 4 times a month) send an email to **newsletter@iwlafred-rapp.org** and request your name be added to the distribution list.
- Video camera technology is used for surveillance at the chapter grounds and a video recorder maintains a persistent record.
- Both entries and exits to the Chapter grounds through the gate are monitored using RFID technology embedded in the All-in-One Access card.
- All-in-One Access cards are required to be worn on your person and visible to other users and RSOs while using the Chapter ranges.
- A Chapter apiary (10 or more honeybee hives) is maintained on the property to the archery range side of the fishing pond.
